

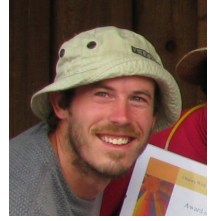


LEADERSHIP TEAM:

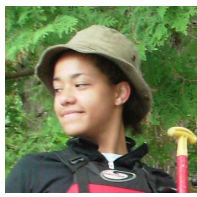
